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10. BACKGROUND:

LCPA's Maintenance Department, Airport Police Department, and Airport Operations Department collaborated to identify seven (7) airfield perimeter vehicle gates requiring hardening measures designed to mitigate a vehicle breach. Some of the information related to this work (like specific gate locations, etc.) is considered Sensitive Security Information (SSI).

LCPA intends to award the project to Global Grab Technologies piggybacking The Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS) RFP 230202 Security Systems Products contract. The quoted cost per gate provided in the Statement of Work & Compensation is \$57,461.63. Due to complexities and variables associated with this project, LCPA proposes a 10% contingency on top of the quoted price, bringing the estimated, not-to-exceed cost of \$442,454.53, a \$40,223.14 contingency.
